Social Skills

No matter what your stage in life, it is essential to have the ability to communicate and interact with others in a meaningful way. Caregivers can help children learn how to make friends and the characteristics of good friends. However, social development goes beyond making friends; it includes the ability to follow direction, appreciate differences and share in experiences with others.
